

Build the Belaire Townhomes

We are excited to introduce to you the Belaire Townhomes. These seven townhomes will be built in the rear yards of our three existing homes on Belaire Avenue. Phase one is to build four townhomes with three more to be added as part of this long-term project. Using our existing land mass (rear yards) allows us to construct these homes at a very affordable level. Each townhome has two parking spaces on the ground level. The first floor contains the living room, dining room, kitchen, bathroom and laundry room. On the second level are four bedrooms and a bathroom. These homes will be used for transitional housing purposes.





By donating to the construction of the new Belaire Townhomes, you are supporting 28 men who have completed their initial addiction recovery program and are now working on the Next Steps Program which is designed to provide a variety of life skills training. This includes employment training, how to build a resume, how to be a good dad and husband, communication skills, setting boundaries, relapse prevention and more.

You know all that is involved in running a home; meals, laundry, cleaning, house, yardwork, auto maintenance, and budgeting. Add to that, the emotional, mental and spiritual care and support and recovery work (which is the hardest work of all). Multiply these current needs by 8 homes and 90 people! Your Home Management gift helps to liberate the mind, heal the heart, nourish the body, and meet the physical needs.

Personal Development

We have learned each man's journey is unique so we have created a step-by-step personal development program. Addiction can rob an individual of their sense of dignity, destroy self-worth and eliminate purpose. We are dedicated to walking alongside men to find freedom and rediscover, and for some, discover for the very first time, a passion and career.

1 Month = \$400



First Step: 90 Day Program

The 90 Day Program is mandatory for each client. It is a comprehensive in-depth dive into their own personal addiction and a roadmap of rediscovery and remaking of themselves.

1 Month = \$1800 per person




Capital Project: 2 Wheelchair-Accessible Bedrooms with a Multi-Purpose Room

Help to build two wheelchairaccessible bedrooms and a multi-purpose room complete with bathrooms and galley kitchen.

1 Bedroom = \$1800

Multi-Purpose Room = \$15,000



Sponsor Next Steps Programming

Next Steps is a person-centered, strength-based, and collaborative program that transitions 90 Day program graduates into further education, employment, and permanent housing opportunities.

Once a client is in the Next Steps Program they are eligible to participate in the following separately funded programs

1 Month = \$1800 per person



Education for Work In-House Employment Program (IHEP)

Help our clients get back in the workplace and overcome the barriers that have been in their way. Provide much-needed training through hands-on work experience.

1 Hour = \$17 1 Day = \$136 1 Month = \$2720 6 Months = \$16,320

Tool Loan

The Tool Loan program facilitates the journey of rediscovery and remaking for some men involves returning to or a learning a new trade or going to school. The spirit of this program is to assist Next Step clients, ready to re-enter the workplace but don't have the funds, clothing, or basic tools to get started.

It began with a donor's heart seeing the need. He chatted with staff, then made a \$10,000 donation to stock tools to get it started!

1 Set of Tools = \$100

1 Set of Work Clothes = \$80

Healthcare Loan Program (HELP)

The Healthcare Loan Program offers eligible residents healthcare assistance, either for dental or vision costs, can apply to receive funding and repay the loan in installments.



Build Hope with Special Events & Recreation

In addition to our core programming, we recognize that rebuilding lives requires working on relationships and building other skills, which is why we provide special events for our clients.



12 Days of Christmas

The 12 days of Christmas gives the guys structured, fun, sober events to participate in so that they can be successful in their recovery through what can be an otherwise challenging season.

1 Activity = \$100



Christmas Gifts for Clients' Kids

We are not asking for donations but we wanted you to know in partnership with Salvation Army and Joshua Tree the clients' children will all receive a gift from their father this Christmas.

Christmas gift = \$50



Recreation & Camp Retreats

Our men are working hard on their recovery and rebuilding their lives. We believe in living wholly and part of that is having fun. Weekends can be tough and triggering so we try to provide fun weekend activities throughout the year, such as axe throwing, swimming, wall climbing, hiking. Some of these are free to attend but still require transport and staffing. Additionally, we take all the guys to a camp for a weekend retreat twice a year.

Weekend Camp Retreat = \$3000

Weekend Activity = \$35

Provide a Home at Ethel Glen

Ethel Glen House* is a supportive housing facility for fourteen residents, both men and women, who live with chronic mental health challenges.

Residents, ranging from their mid-30s to 70 years of age, often become long-term members of the Ethel Glen House community.

1 Month = \$1800 per person

*Freedom's Door manages a "sister society" known as Ethel Glen. This home has existed for over 20 years and is specifically designed to provide a safe, affordable and caring home for men and women with mental health struggles. Healthy food, a comfortable room, activities, and a loving family environment allows for security and engagement for residents for whom life has not been easy. We have 14 bedrooms and rely on community donations to keep the rents affordable.
